Located at 7 Trillium Lane in Falmouth, Maine, PFG is a state-of-the-art indoor facility with a 1000sq air conditioned training center that features exceptional Crown Comfort King agility flooring. The training center is a green business, with solar heat and solar air conditioning. There are also outdoor agility and obedience rings. Set on 11 acres of fields bordered by a pretty river, with a land trust on the opposite banks, it is a safe and gorgeous location.

Crating, Parking and Seating:

There is ample onsite parking convenient to the building, but ***no indoor crating*** at this event. Participants should plan to work directly from their vehicles. Please be mindful of the environment and clean up after your dog as necessary throughout the property and facility. Chairs are available to participants and auditors, or you are welcome to bring you own.

Please be mindful that dogs participating in such events may have “personal space” issues. As a result, please manage your dog well to minimize any problems.

What to Bring

Flat buckle collar or martingale as well as a 4’ to 6’ leash are appropriate. No prongs or training collars. Aversive corrections are not part of our training philosophy at PGF.

Bring your sense of adventure (and humor) as well as a hungry dog. Training new behaviors requires a higher rate of reinforcement at the beginning, so please bring lots of small, chewy treats.
